# procedure

## HOW TO TAKE SAMPLES FOR ANALYSIS?

Taking a representative sample of your hay stock.

### SMALL STACKS

Choose 10 to 20 stacks randomly avoiding outside stacks or stacks on the heap surface. Collect 1 to 2 handles inside each stack (ideally stacks should be opened). Gather everything in a bucket and mix gently (to avoid leaves from falling at the bottom of the container).

After homogenization, keep only 10 handles, about 300 g of product.

### LARGE STACKS (ROUND FOR SQUARE)

Choose 5 to 10 stacks randomly avoiding outside stacks or stacks on the heap surface. Collect 1 handle at 3 different spots inside each stack (ideally stacks should be opened).

Gather everything in a bucket and mix gently (to avoid leaves from falling at the bottom of the container).

After homogenization, keep only 10 handles, about 300 g of product.

## PACKAGING

Any sample of hay must be accompanied by an information form. In case of multiple sendings, it is important to correctly identify the different samples onto the bags and on the information forms.

Put the 300 g into a waterproof and resistant bag (large freezer bag or garbage bag type).

Evacuate residual air from the bag to avoid breathing from the sample.

Carefully close the bag.

Place the bag in a suitable box (shoe box type).
